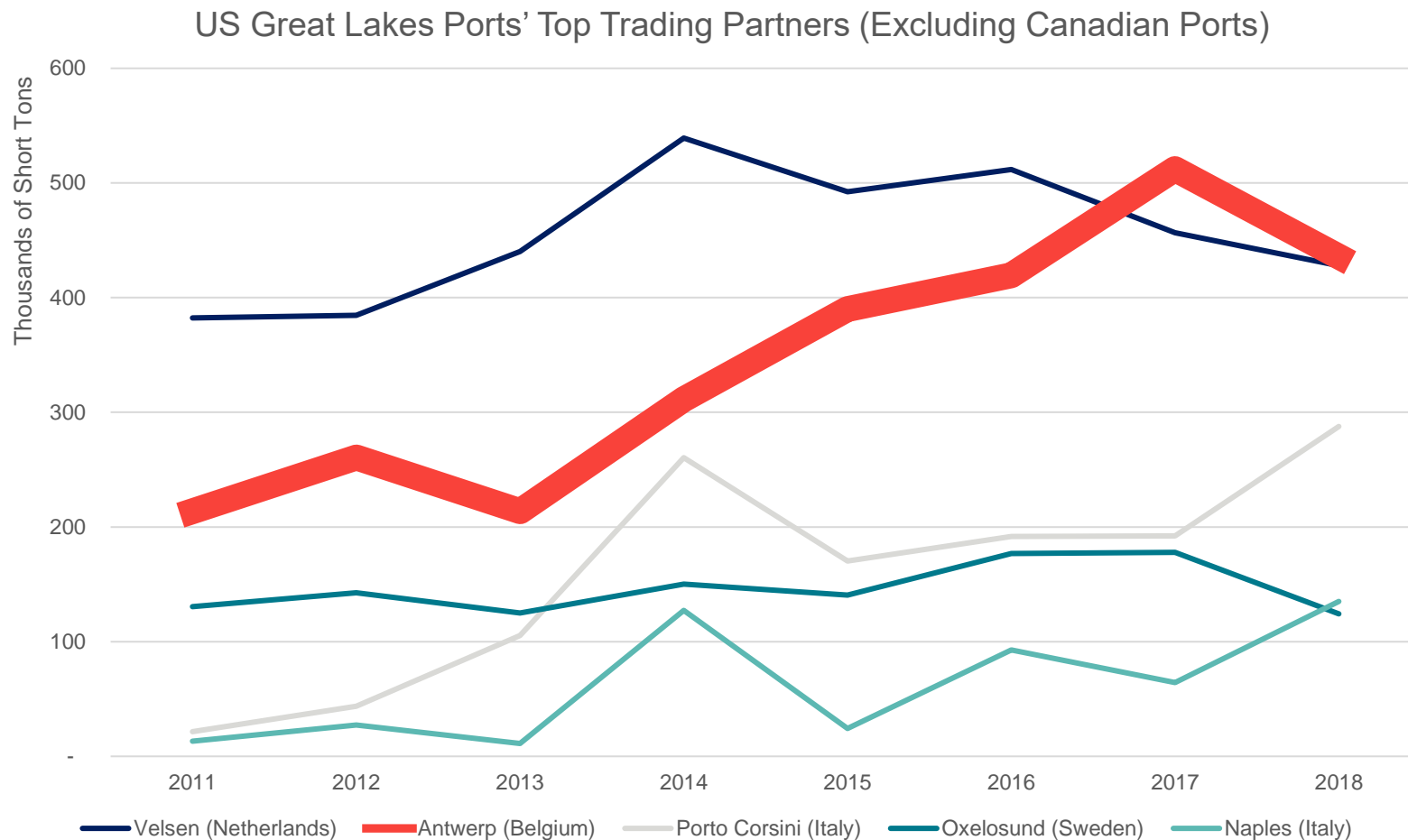

Antwerp has become a top European port for GLSLS exports and imports

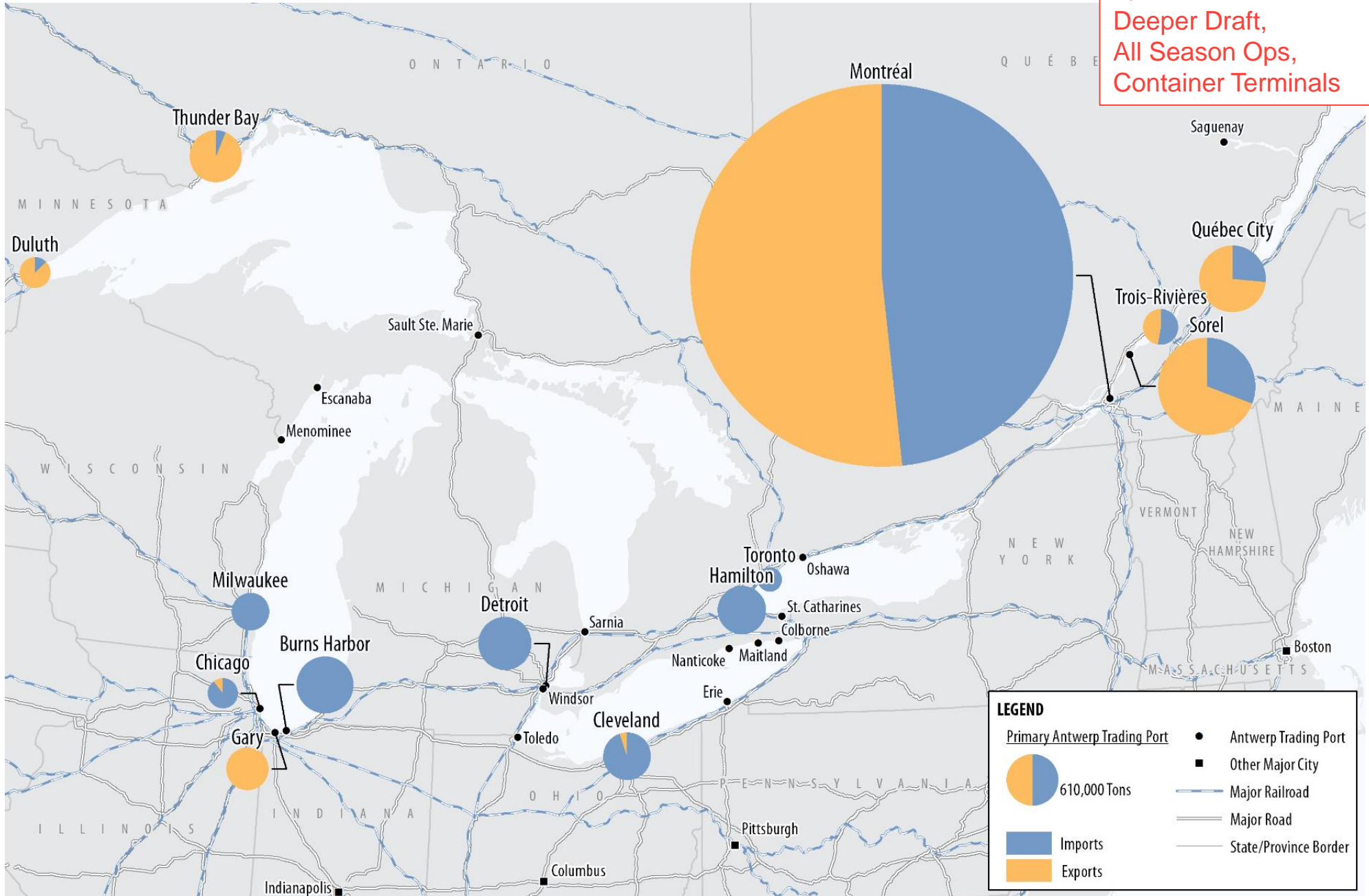

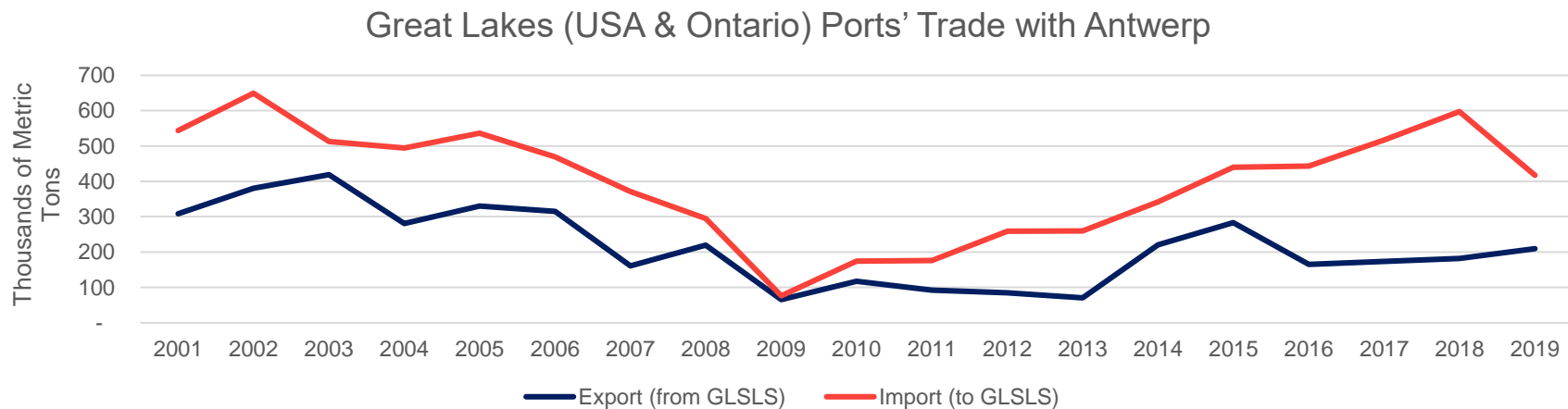
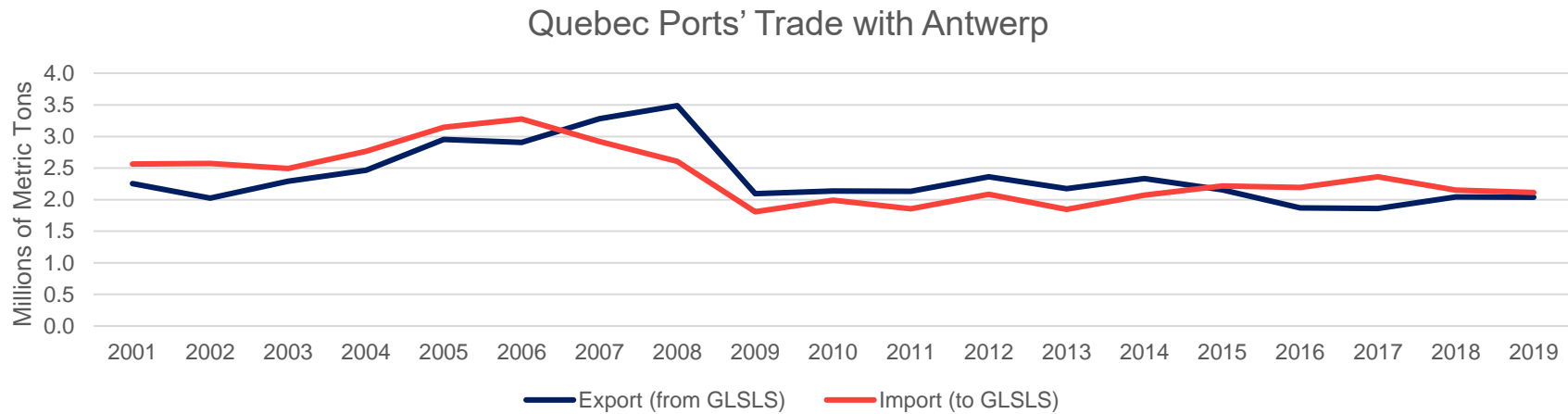
Trade with Antwerp is relevant to ports across the GLSLS:

4.2 million metric tons was moved in 2019, 85% of this tonnage was to/from Quebec

What goods are traded with Antwerp?

Quebec: balanced containerized imports and exports

Great Lakes: “steel in, grains out”
