



1-1. Aerospace

According to the U.S. Department of Commerce data as of May 2023, the U.S' aerospace export to South Korea recorded a total of \$2.2 billion in 2022.



U.S. Export to South Korea in 2022

- Civilian aircraft, engines and parts made up nearly 80% of the export valued at \$1.7 billion
- Aircraft launch gear, spacecraft parts, parachutes, unmanned aircraft and others accounted for about 20%
- 72% of South Korea's total volume of aerospace imports were from the United States.








1-2. Defense

- For 2023, South Korea allocated \$48.3 billion or 8.9 percent of its total government expenditure to its defense budget.
- August 2024, the U.S. approves \$3.5 billion sale of Apache helicopters to South Korea



2. Medical Device

- Since the outbreak of COVID-19 in 2020, there have been substantial changes in the Korean medical device market.
- U.S. medical devices are ranked first in the Korean import market, with market share steadily maintained between 40 to 50 percent.






3. Pharmaceutical

The pharmaceutical market rose by 5.3 percent in 2023 compared to the previous year, reaching an all-time high of \$31.34 billion.

Korea has emerged as a global hub for Pharmaceutical CDMO. Notably, Songdo stands out as the Rank #1 city with the highest pharmaceutical production capacity in the world, surpassing San Francisco, Singapore, and Ireland.

4. E-commerce


E-Commerce is the biggest retail channel in Korea.

5. Advanced Manufacturing – Robot, Al

According to Research and Markets report, South Korea's advanced manufacturing market size was valued at \$192.8 billion in 2022 and is projected to reach \$445.7 billion by 2027.

Market opportunities exist for the U.S. companies to be major suppliers of such manufacturing technology, including advancing sectors like high-end automation equipment, industrial robotics, and industrial additive manufacturing.




6. Food & Beverage

South Korea is the 5th largest export market for the U.S. South Korea imported about \$43 billion agricultural & food products from all over the world and the U.S. exported \$10.5 billion in agricultural products to Korea.

Alcoholic beverage market in South Korea experienced a notable increase of \$9.1 billion in 2022.

Imports of scotch, bourbon, and whiskey surged by 16,884 tons, a substantial increase of nearly 51% compared to the same period last year

Total imported alcoholic beverages amounted to \$1.6 billion. Notably, fruit wines and other wine varieties maintained the highest market share at 42.1%.





7. Education Technology

The education technology industry in Korea is advancing and presents potential growth areas for education technology suppliers. Developments are progressing in mobile learning environments, online learning analytics for instructional design, and artificial intelligence for science research.




The Korean EdTech industry size was \$5.2 billion in 2023 and is projected to reach \$7.7 billion in 2025 at an 8.5 percent growth rate. This is, in part, driven by government initiatives, including the Korean Ministry of Social Affairs and Education's plan to introduce digital textbooks and artificial intelligence (AI) tutors by 2025.






8. ICT – Cyber Security

S. Korea ranked the 1st in excellent ICT infrastructure and boasts one of the world's highest percentage of households with access to the Internet. Also, leading the world in terms of high-speed internet penetration rate.
