WHY SOUTH KOREA?

The US and South Korea have a strong trade relationship, with the establishment of the free trade agreement in 2012. The country is the fourth largest market in Asia and has many world-class companies.

Key sectors for US exports include aerospace, agriculture, air pollution control, construction services, cosmetics, energy, IT, manufacturing technology, medical devices, and specialty chemicals, among others. In 2023, the US exported \$64.84 billion to South Korea.
