Join the Great Lakes St. Lawrence Governors and Premiers multi-sector Virtual Trade Mission to Mexico June -July 2, 2021. Similar to the process used for in-person trade missions, participants will receive a prescreened virtual b2b meeting schedule with potential distributors, buyers, and joint venture partners. The virtual trade mission format allows companies to extend their geographic reach in Mexico as meetings are not limited to specific cities or regions. Participants will also benefit from market sector briefings, an online meeting platform and support from the GSGP Mexico Trade Office.

Mexico's most promising sectors for U.S. exporters include agriculture; agribusiness; auto parts and services; aerospace; education services; energy; environmental technology; franchising; housing and construction; packaging equipment; plastics and resins; security and safety equipment and services; information technology; transportation infrastructure equipment and services; and travel and tourism services.
